SHORT WALK – SOUTH

Sutton Bank, on the edge of the North York Moors National Park, provides spectacular views over the Vale of York. From here you can spot gliders soaring above, watch the weather roll in from the west, gaze at the starry night sky or enjoy a bike ride through beautiful woodland.

- 1 Starting from the Sutton Bank Visitor Centre head towards the Bank itself, crossing the main road with care.
- 2 Follow the Cleveland Way south for 2.2Km through to the White Horse.
- 3 Turn right and descend the steps beyond the White Horse.
- 4 At the bottom car park turn right and along the track for 900 metres.
- 5 Turn right on the path known as the Thieves Highway, leading back up to the Cleveland Way at the top and return to the Visitor Centre.
