


# 'Scramble' through the Wainstones



# 'Scramble' through the Wainstones

## LONG WALK

A more adventurous walk up Hasty Bank to the unique Wainstones will not disappoint. As the only part of the Cleveland Way where you need to use your hands for a very short scramble, the Wainstones present a small yet satisfying challenge.

- 1 From the car park turn left up the road to Chop Gate.
- 2 At Chop Gate turn left towards Carlton and immediately right to walk behind the buildings and up to the top of the lane.
- 3 Go through the gates and follow the path roughly parallel to the drystone wall and the woodland on your right. Keep to the uphill path.
- 4 Follow the path as it bears left and goes up the side of Cold Moor.
- 5 Continue ahead along the top of Cold Moor.
- 6 On reaching the Cleveland Way turn right and follow the surfaced path.
- 7 Continue straight on through the fields and up past the Wainstones.
- 8 Follow the Cleveland Way over Hasty Bank and down the far side.
- 9 Go through the Kissing gate and turn right down the stone path to the main road.
- 10 Cross the road, go through the gate and continue along the Cleveland Way.
- 11 Very shortly after the gate at the top of the hill, bear right off the main route on the path leading along the edge of the earthwork.
- 12 Cross the stream gully and continue along the path.
- 13 Cross another gully and continue along the path.
- 14 Cross the boggy section towards the drystone wall and follow the path alongside it.
- 15 Turn sharp right down the sunken track which leads off Urra Moor.
- 16 Go through the gate and continue down the path.
- 17 Go through the gate and follow the track to Bilsdale Hall. Turn left at the road.
- 18 Turn left at the main road and follow the pavement to return to Chop Gate car park.
